The Oliver Wolcott Library reserves the right to modify or remove any comments, posts, or messages that it deems, in its sole discretion, to be abusive; obscene; defamatory; in violation of copyright, trademark or other intellectual property right of any third party; promotion of a commercial interest; solicitation of any kind including fundraising and politic solicitation; not relating to the topic; or otherwise inappropriate. The Oliver Wolcott Library advises all users to be courteous and respectful of others. Posts, comments and participation should be focused on the topic.

Social networking venues offer access to many users from many inputs and are generally available for public viewing. The Oliver Wolcott Library advises users to not post or comment on any private or confidential information.
